**OPENING of CONFERENCE** The 110th Annual Conference was opened by **Hon John McVeigh**, Minister for Agriculture, Fisheries and Forestry on Thursday at 12.15pm.

**GUEST SPEAKERS:** **1. Dr Paulo Souza - CSIRO** delivered the **2014 Charles Roff Memorial Address: "Micro-sensors on bees: the key for understanding their whereabouts"**.

*Thousands of honey bees in Australia are being fitted with tiny sensors as part of a world-first research program to monitor the insects and their environment using a technique known as 'swarm sensing'.*

*The research is being led by CSIRO and aims to improve honey bee pollination and productivity on farms as well as help understand the drivers of bee Colony Collapse Disorder (CCD), a condition decimating honey bee populations worldwide. [Read more:](#)*

**2. Cleofas Rodriguez Cervancia - University of the Phillipines** will present the **2014 Tony Knight Address: "Is there resource competition between *Apis cerana* and *Apis mellifera*?"**.

A second presentation was given titled: **"Potential of Stingless Bees for Pollination and Honey and Pollen Production"**.

Cleo is currently the head of the Bee Program and leads the scientific committee of the Asian Bee Congress.
